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Půlnoční capriccio

vzniklo v roce 2020 pro sólové housle z podnětu Milana Paľy a je mu také věnováno. Milan Paľa požádal řadu slovenských a českých skladatelů, aby mu napsali capriccio do 5 minut. Vzniklo tak přes dvacet krátkých skladeb. K jejich společnému koncertnímu provedení kvůli pandemii covidu-19 zatím nedošlo, ale v roce 2022 Milan Paľa capriccia kompletně vydal na CD. Vzhledem k tomu, že hráčské dovednosti Milana Paľy jsou neomezené, neměl jsem tedy žádné omezení v technické náročnosti.

V roce 2023 jsem skladbu přepracoval pro sólovou flétnu. Jsem si vědom toho, že to je skladba náročná a věřím, že alespoň některé flétnisty zaujem, aby se ujali jejího provozování.

Midnight Capriccio

was created in 2020 for solo violin at the suggestion of Milan Paľa and it is also dedicated to him. Milan Paľa asked a number of Slovak and Czech composers to write him a capriccio within 5 minutes. This resulted in over twenty short compositions. Their joint concert performance has not yet taken place due to the covid-19 pandemic, but in 2022, Milan Paľa capriccia was released in its entirety on CD. Given that Milan Paľa's playing skills are unlimited, I had no limitations in terms of technical difficulty.

In 2023, I reworked the piece for solo flute. I am aware that this is a demanding composition and I believe that it will interest at least some flautists to undertake its performance.
